## National Security Council – Strategic Trade Management Committee (NSC-STMCom)

RESOLUTION NO. 04 (2021): Approval and Publication of the National Strategic Goods List Annex 3 (Nationally Controlled Goods) of Republic Act No. 10697, also known as the Strategic Trade Management Act (STMA) of 2015.

Adopted and signed by the National Security Council – Strategic Trade Management Committee at its <u>sixth</u> (6th) <u>regular meeting</u> on <u>26 January 2021</u>.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Republic Act No. 10697 or the Strategic Trade Management Act (STMA) of 2015 states that the National Strategic Goods List (NSGL) shall describe with specificity the strategic goods subject to authorization and shall be in conformity with international commitments and nonproliferation obligations pursuant to bilateral and multilateral treaties, international conventions and international nonproliferation regimes.

WHEREAS, the UN Security Council Resolutions 1718 and 2231 impose measures against individuals and entities upon their violation of international law including international criminal law, international humanitarian law, and other pertinent laws of the international community.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the STMA provides that the NSGL shall consist of three (3) annexes, Military Goods (Annex 1), Dual Use Goods (Annex 2), and Nationally Controlled Goods (Annex 3).

WHEREAS, Section 5(O), of the STMA defines Annex 3 or the Nationally Controlled Goods as strategic goods placed under unilateral controls for reasons of national security, foreign policy, anti-terrorism, crime control, and public safety.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the STMA creates the National Security Council – Strategic Trade Management Committee (NSC-STMCom) composed of the: (1) Executive Secretary as Chairperson, (2) the Secretary of Trade and Industry as the Vice-Chairperson, and the Secretary of Foreign Affairs; (4) the Secretary of Justice; (5) the Secretary of National Defense; (6) the Secretary of the Interior and Local Government; (7) the Secretary of Finance; (8) the Secretary of Transportation; (9) the National Security Advisor; (10) the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources; (11) the Secretary of Science and Technology; (12) the Secretary of Agriculture; (13) the Secretary of Health; and (14) the Secretary of Information and Communications Technology as Members.

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of the STMA provides that one of the powers and functions of the NSC-STMCom is to establish, publish, review and update the NSGL.

Now, therefore, we the NSC-STMCom Members agree and promulgate:

**THAT** the NSGL Annex 3 (Nationally Controlled Goods), as attached, is hereby adopted.

**THAT** the Anti-Terrorism Council – Program Management Center, as the NSC-STMCom Secretariat, and the Strategic Trade Management Office shall publish NSGL Annex 3 consistent with Section 4 of the STMA.

THAT the NSGL Annex 3 shall take effect immediately after its publication.
