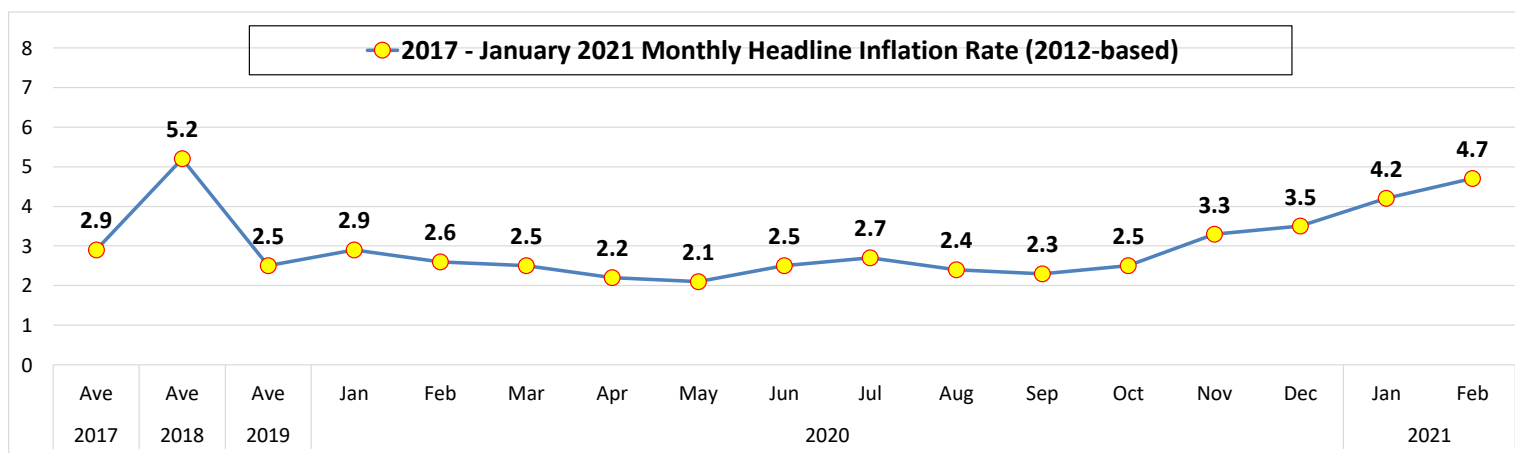

The country's headline inflation rate at the national level for 2021 continued to rise as it reached 4.7 in February 2021. Last month, it was recorded at 4.2 percent and in February 2020, 2.6 percent.

Higher annual increments were noted in the following indices: food and non-alcoholic beverages; alcoholic beverages and tobacco; housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels; health; transport; communication; and restaurant and miscellaneous goods and services. However, slower increments were noted in the furnishing, household equipment and routine maintenance of the house index.
